## TUSCANY IS CROSSED BY:

- THE MAJOR ITALIAN HIGHWAY (A1) CONNECTING MILAN WITH ROME AND NAPLES
- THE EU SCANDINAVIAN-MEDITERRANEAN CORE NETWORK CORRIDOR LINKING THE BALTIC SEA WITH SOUTHERN ITALY AND MALTA
